Notice is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors (“**Board**”) of the Indiantown Community Development District (“**District**”) will hold a telephonic public meeting of the Board on April 13, 2020 at 1:00 p.m.

The meeting is to be conducted by telephonic means of communications media technology, pursuant to Executive Orders 20-52 and 20-69 issued by Governor DeSantis on March 9, 2020, and March 20, 2020, respectively, and pursuant to Section 120.54(5)(b)2., Florida Statutes. The meeting is being held for the necessary public purpose of approving the Fiscal Year 2021 Proposed Budget and at such time the Board is so authorized and may consider any other business that may properly come before it.
